NCBDE is a national not-for-profit certification organization that awards the CDE® credential to qualified individuals and there are currently over 19,700 health professionals holding the CDE® credential. The CDE® program is accredited through the National Commission for Certifying Agencies.

NCBDE was established in 1986 to develop and administer a certification program for health professionals who facilitate people in acquiring the knowledge, skill, and ability necessary for prediabetes and diabetes self-care, as well as activities that assist a person in implementing and sustaining the health practices needed to manage the condition on an ongoing basis, beyond or outside of formal self-management training.
